
A PARENT'S ROADMAP TO GETTING MORE SUPPORT AT SCHOOL

You email the school principal and school psychologist to ask for a special education evaluation.

The school has 60 days to conduct the evaluation. They should have informed you of what they will be doing during the consent process.



You notice your child struggling in school. This struggle is ongoing, and you and the teacher(s) have tried some things that haven't helped. You believe the struggle is related to your child's diagnosis.

The school has 14 days to respond to your request and either deny the request or arrange for you to give consent for them to conduct the evaluation.

Deciding

You will meet with the educational team to hear about the evaluation results and decide as a team if your child qualifies for an IEP or a 504 plan.
