



Fee Schedule

FSA's Fee Schedule is based on [Federal Poverty Level Guidelines](#).

Percentage of Poverty Level	Percentage of Full Fee Charged
100 to 199%	2%
200 to 299%	5%
300 to 399%	15%
400 to 499%	40%
500 to 599%	75%
600% and above	100%

FSA's Current Full Fees per hour of service:

Service	Fee
Individual, Family Therapy, Assessment, Treatment Planning, Crisis Intervention	\$175
Psychiatric Assessment and Medication Monitoring	\$300
Case Management, Consultation, Community Support/Therapeutic Mentoring	\$155
Group Therapy	\$60

Follow this example to determine the fee:

Lupe comes in for services. She makes \$45,000 and is responsible for herself and her two children under the age of 18. Her household is made up of 3. In 2021, the [Federal Poverty Level Guidelines](#) (FPL) for a family of 3 is \$23,030. $45000/23030=1.95$. Lupe makes 195% of (FPL) and will be charged 2% of the full fee. This means that the fee schedule for her family is: Therapy Services $175 \times 0.02 = \$3.50$; Psychiatric Services $300 \times 0.02 = \$6.00$; Case Management $155 \times 0.02 = \$3.10$; Group Therapy $60 \times 0.02 = \$3.00$.
